Kingsville Garbage Collection

- Your garbage will be collected weekly on Tuesday OR Friday. We request that you locate your street on the map provided (see below) & identify which day your street will receive weekly collection.



5 Bag / Can Limit

- **Large Items & Furniture:** Will be picked up on your regularly scheduled garbage day (with the exception of white goods). Items such as box springs, mattresses, couches, chairs, and similar materials can be put out on any regular garbage day.
- If you have questions regarding your garbage collection please call GFL Environmental Inc. at 519-944-8009.
- Your time of collection will vary according to the season and amount of waste being collected. Any long weekend and holiday will result in an earlier than usual time of collection. Please place your garbage in a suitable container and have it at the roadside/curb the night before your collection day.
- **Unacceptable Garbage Containers:** Do not place garbage out in containers that are:
 - **Oversized & Overweight:** Containers cannot weigh over 20 kg / 45 lbs.
 - **Plastic Shopping Bags:** Do NOT place them at the curb.
 - **Cardboard Boxes:** Recycle or use for Yard Waste!
- **NON-COLLECTABLE Waste:** Waste that is deemed non-collectable includes: ammunition, animal carcasses, animal waste, appliances, automotive parts, bricks, combustibles, chemical waste, computer equipment, concrete, construction & demolition waste, explosives, industrial waste, liquid waste, medical waste, metal items, pallets, paint products, renovation debris, syringes, televisions, and tires.

These items are not garbage and will NOT be collected – **check index for Public Drop Off information.**

5 Bag / Can Limit

Plastic Bags

- TIED Commercial grade plastic bags only
- Recommended size: 26" X 36"
- Never put sharp objects in plastic bags

Metal or Plastic Cans

- Maximum 125L / 30 gal. capacity
- Maximum 78 cm/31" tall, 20" diameter
- 2 handles and a water tight lid

White Goods / Appliances:

White Goods are collected the first Tuesday of each month. Please call **519-733-2305** (the week prior) to be placed on a list for pick up. (i.e. metal items, hot water tanks, bbq's, bathtubs, sinks, etc.).

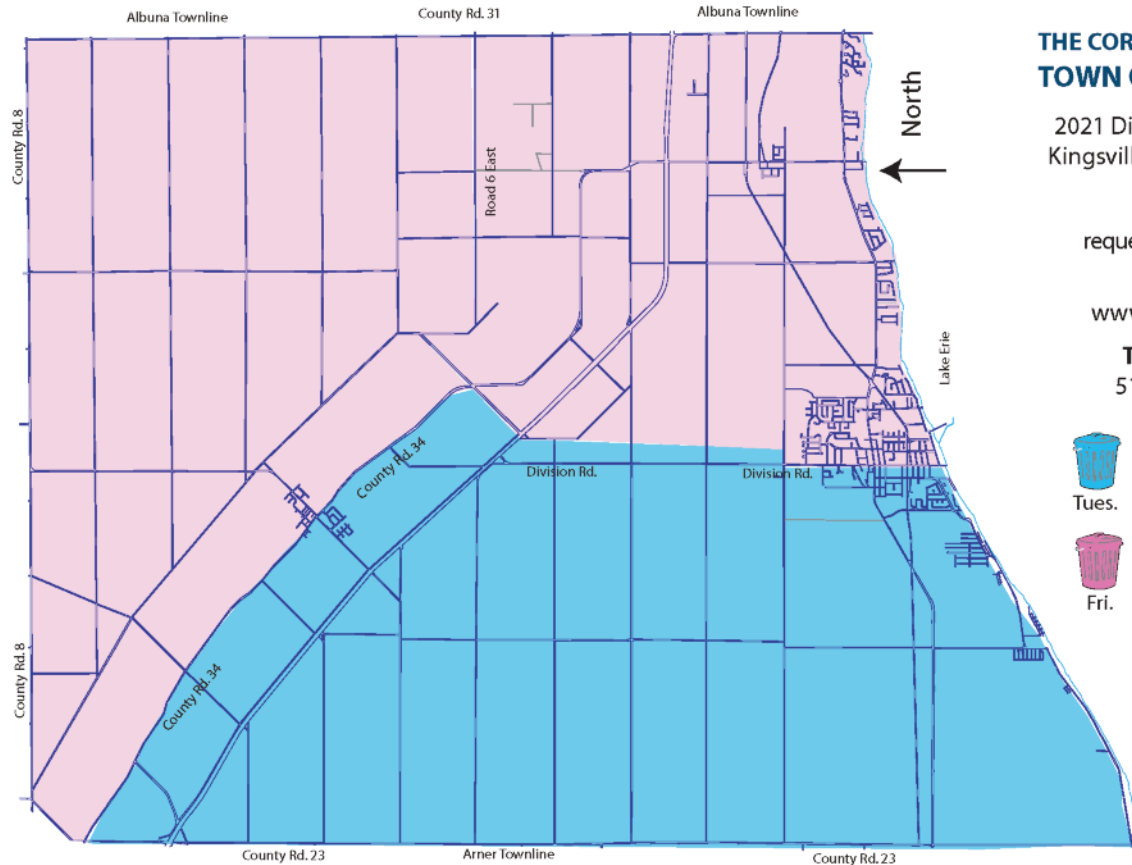

Yard Waste Collection

Basic Collection Requirements:

- **Yard waste is defined as grass, leaves, garden trimmings, brush, tree trimmings.**
- **Any yard waste in PLASTIC BAGS will NOT be collected.**
- **Yard waste CANNOT exceed 22 kg. or 50 lbs. per container.**

The **only ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS** for yard waste are:



- **Paper Yard Waste Bag**
- **Cardboard Boxes**
- **Garbage Cans / Pails**

No Plastic Bags for Yard Waste!

2024 Yard Waste / Brush Collection Information:

ALL yard waste and brush days are FREE.

RURAL AREAS ONLY must CALL 519.733.2305 prior to the yard waste/brush pick up date to be placed on the list.

To view yard waste /brush collection route maps go to www.kingsville.ca under "Garbage and Recycling".

Place your yard waste out for collection on the day BEFORE the day noted in the calendar. Your yard waste and brush will be picked up FREE of charge.

Christmas Tree Recycling Requirements

Please do NOT dispose of your natural Christmas tree in the garbage. Instead, residents may drop off live Christmas trees at one of the designated municipal locations below, starting Dec 26th and ending Jan 31st.

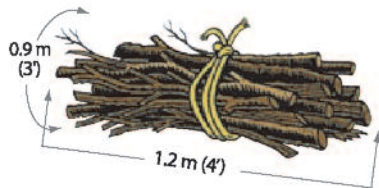

All decorations, tree skirts, plastic tree bags, etc. must be removed. The Town provides door-to-door pickup, **by appointment only**, on January 13, 14, 15, 2025. If you require a pick-up, please call **519-733-2305** in advance to schedule.

2024 Brush Collection Information:

- Brush and branches should be tied in bundles no more than 45 lbs (20 kg) and no more than 3' high (.9 m) by 4' long (1.2 m) - the diameter cannot exceed 3" (7.5 cm).



- Any untied, loose piles of brush will NOT be collected.
- Place your brush out for collection on the 'brush' day noted in the calendar. You do NOT have to call first.
- !** The Town of Kingsville is NOT responsible for large quantities of brush left by commercial tree trimmers working on private property.



NOTE: Yard Waste & Brush MUST be at the curb the night before for early pickup time.



← Look for the Paper Yard Waste Bag symbol. It indicates a Yard Waste Collection Day.



← Look for the Brush symbol. It indicates a Brush Collection Day. Place your brush out for collection on this day (you do not have to call first).



REMINDER: Leaves will not be collected in plastic bags or in loose piles on boulevards and streets. **Leaves are collected with Yard Waste Collection.**

Seasonal hydrant flushing in the Town of Kingsville will be conducted as required from **April to November.**

Hydrant flushing is a normal maintenance procedure and may result in customers experiencing rusty or milky water conditions. Please check when running water and if discolouration occurs, run cold water taps until the water clears.



Hydrant flushing will occur between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

All customers should note that flushing of water mains may be required without notification at various times throughout the year in order to ensure water quality.



Basement Flooding Subsidy Program

Did you know that the Town of Kingsville offers a basement flooding protection subsidy? The program was created to assist homeowners in reducing the risk of flooding on their private property by covering a portion of the cost to install a backwater valve and sump pump.

Here are some additional details:

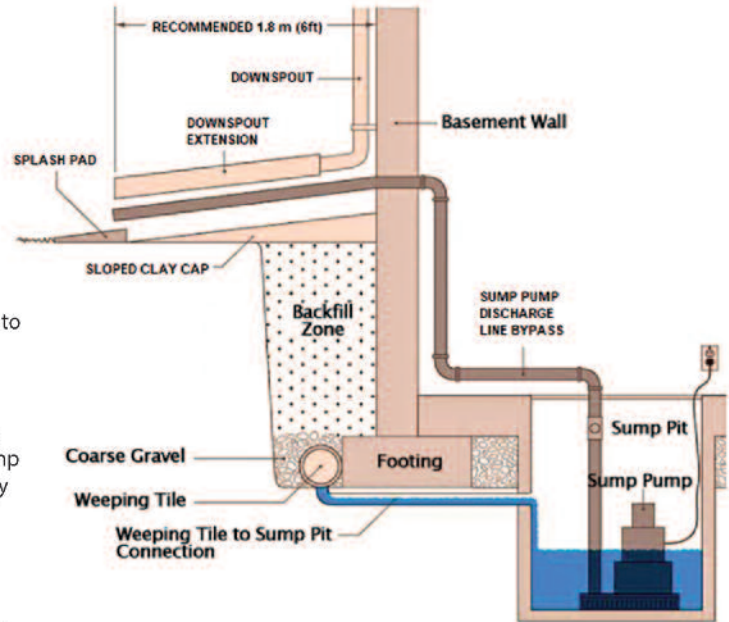
- The program covers up to 50% of the cost to install a backwater valve (\$750.00 maximum), up to 50% of the cost to install a sump pump to disconnect foundation drains to floor drains (\$750.00 maximum) and up to 50% of the cost to install both (\$1500.00 maximum). Building permit required.
- The program does **NOT** cover the replacement or upgrade of an existing sump pump, addition of another sump pump, installation of a sump pump when foundation drains are already separated from floor drain or sanitary sewer or work performed by which a permit cannot be obtained.

Eligibility

The program is available to homeowners who live in the Town of Kingsville and do not have amounts owing to the Town such as back taxes or overdue payments

Requirements















All work must be performed by a licensed contractor/licensed plumber or master plumber. Any work performed by the homeowner does **NOT** qualify for the program. You can apply for the subsidy on our website at www.kingsville.ca

No Grease Down The Drain

An important message from Kingsville Environmental Services



Do NOT pour left over cooking grease down the sink.

Please be mindful of what you put down your sink and toilet. These items are not to be used as garbages. Grease and oils from cooking should never be poured into the drain or flushed. When this happens, it sticks to the sides of the pipes causing blockages that can be costly to repair for both the Town and property owners.

The only thing to be flushed down the toilet is toilet paper. Any garbage flushed down the toilet can cause blockages, issues at the treatment plant and pumping stations.

Did you know?

The stickers on fruit should NEVER be washed down the sink - they can cause blockages at the treatment plant.



Please do not flush:

- cleaning wipes (even if flushable)
- unused medications
- disposable diapers
- paper towels
- feminine hygiene products
- cotton balls and swabs

Kingsville Snow Removal

Snow Removal

Kingsville maintains over 270 km of municipal roads, 54 km of sidewalks, and 12 municipal parking lots. Plowing roads, sidewalks, and parking lots is not possible when there are vehicles or objects blocking the snow plows. To help facilitate snow removal or treatment of icy roads, By-Law 63-2022 allows the Town to declare on-street parking bans through the winter. Once declared, the ban is in effect for 72 hours. The Town will provide notice of bans on its website and/or social media platforms. Parking on the street during a ban carries a \$35 fine.

Residents and businesses must also remove portable items (including basketball nets, garbage cans, portable signs, etc.) from roadways and sidewalks to receive the best possible service and prevent potential damage.

Mailbox Damage

During snow removal operations, the Town of Kingsville will only replace mailboxes that are damaged by the snowplows. We will NOT replace or repair mailboxes that are damaged by thrown snow. The homeowner is SOLELY responsible for the installation and maintenance of the replacement mailbox.



When Will Snow be Cleared

The Town of Kingsville removes snow accumulations on roads of 8 cm or more 12-24 hours after the snowfall has ended, including snow drifting events. All available staff and equipment are dispatched immediately and remain out until roads are safe for public travel.

We follow an essential snow removal order based on provincial standards and best safety practices. We plow sidewalks and parking lots after snow accumulation reaches 8 cm or more, up to 48 hours after the snowfall ends.
