Accepted materials

Here's a summary of some of the materials that you can recycle!

Paper and cardboard bin



Cardboard: Cereal boxes, egg cartons, corrugated cardboard, paper towel rolls.

Papers: Envelopes, newspaper and flyers.



Container bin



Metal: Food and beverage cans.

Plastic: Plastic containers and bottles.



As of January 1, 2025, Blind River's recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario.

Recycling tips:

- Place recycling at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Sort recyclable materials from garbage and organics.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard (30" X 30" X 8").
- Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- Keep materials loose.
