Accepted materials

Here's a summary of some of the materials that you can recycle!

Cardboard and paper

Cardboard: Cereal boxes, cracker boxes, tissue boxes, paper egg cartons, toilet paper rolls, cardboard, corrugated brown paper bags.

Paper: Household newspaper, magazines, catalogues, flyers, office paper.



Containers

Metal: Tin cans, aluminum cans, pie plates, trays.

Plastic: Plastic food and beverage containers, water bottles, tubs and lids, milk and juice cartons, drinking boxes, and ice cream containers.

Glass: Clear and coloured glass bottles and jars.



As of January 1, 2025, Deep River's recycling program will be managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario.

There is no change to the materials you currently recycle or your recycling schedule.

Recycling tips:

- Sort containers from cardboard and paper.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard.
- Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- Keep materials loose.
