Paper (Green) Box Recyclables Ensure that no loose material is on top that will blow out and cause litter

Blue Box Recyclables Ensure all items are empty and rinsed clean

- ✓ Newspaper & flyers (glossy or plain)
- ✓ Paper bags and cups
- ✓ Fine paper (i.e., writing, computer, mail)
- ✓ Boxboard such as cereal, cracker & cookie boxes, detergent/laundry cartons, file folders, shoe & tissue boxes, apple baskets, over the counter drug boxes (i.e., toothpaste, toiletries, cough syrups, medicine & cosmetics), paper egg cartons, toilet & paper towel rolls & pizza boxes
- ✓ Magazines, catalogues, telephone directories & greeting cards
- ✓ Clean ice cream containers
- √ Frozen juice cans
- ✓ Cardboard & Corrugated cardboard flatten all boxes before placing in Paper Box. Large boxes (no larger than 26"X30") can be flattened and bundled and left beside or under Paper Box.

- ✓ Glass food and beverage bottles & jars including metal lids (removed)
- ✓ Metal food & beverage cans
- ✓ Milk & frozen food bags (clear), bread bags, paper towel & toilet paper wrap, grocery & bulk food bags (clear) – all must have recycling symbol ♣ and contain the number 4
- ✓ Clean empty paint cans lids must be off
- ✓ Plastic bottles only items marked on the bottom with a recycling symbol containing the numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6 (i.e. soft drink, juice & water, LCBO, household detergents, home cleaning & laundry products, windshield washer, vinegar, shampoo & lotion bottles)
- ✓ Aluminum pie plates & foil, rigid foil containers and trays
- Margarine and yogurt tubs

Contaminants that should <u>not</u> be placed in *Paper Box*

- X No cookie bags or pet food bags
- X No Styrofoam
- X No waxed or coated boxes, waxed food boxes & no photos
- X No glass, cans or metal containers
- X No foil gift wrap
- X No used tissue or paper towels

Contaminants that should <u>not</u> be placed in *Blue Box*

- X No motor oil bottles or herbicide/pesticide bottles
- X No Light Bulbs or ceramic
- X No window glass, dishes, mirrors or clear prescription bottles
- X No chip, fertilizer, salt or cookie bags & straws
- X No pots & pans, hard plastic toys or plastic used to insulate windows
- X No paper
- X No Styrofoam
- X No Bubble wrap
- X No CD's
- X No aerosol cans
