All items to the curb by 7 a.m. on your waste collection day.



Maximum weight 23 kilograms (50 pounds) for each bag, bin, or can.



Blue box and green bin weekly collection, no limit.



Garbage collection every second week. Limit of 3 bags/cans for a single-family home.



Bulky item and appliance collection with garbage. Maximum 3.



Yard waste collection spring to fall, every second week opposite garbage.
