### **Accepted materials**

Here's a quick summary of some of the materials that you can recycle!



Cardboard: Cereal boxes, egg cartons, corrugated cardboard, paper towel rolls, tetra paks.



**Papers:** Envelopes, newsprint paper.



Metal: Food and beverage cans, aluminum foil and containers, caps and lids



Plastic: Containers, bottles, wrappings for food products, drinks, cosmetics, personal hygiene products, cleaning products (#1, 2, 5, or 7 only)



Red Lake's recycling program is managed by Circular Materials, a national not-for-profit organization that is committed to building an efficient and effective recycling system in Ontario.

There is no change to the materials you currently recycle or your recycling schedule.

## **Recycling tips:**

- Sort recyclable materials from garbage and organics.
- Flatten and bundle cardboard.
- Empty and give containers a quick rinse.
- **Material** Keep materials loose.

By recycling, you make a difference!






