





2025 Waste Management Schedule and Information



NEW: Green Bins!



- Green bin collection starts the first week of June for residential properties with six or fewer units (excluding the River District).
- Eligible residents will receive a green bin, kitchen catcher, and instructions in mid-May, plus a link to more info.
- Greens bins are for appropriate kitchen waste only (not leaf and yard waste).
- Green bins will be collected weekly on your usual garbage day (e.g., if garbage day is Wednesday, green bin pickup is also Wednesday).
- Garbage collection will continue on a bi-weekly basis.

- Owen Sound's residential recycling is now managed by Circular Materials, a not-for-profit entity focused on efficient recycling in Ontario.
- Residents can use blue boxes or clear bags, but items must be sorted according to the Recycling Guide at: CircularMaterials.ca/OwenSound.
- Only clean, empty recyclable containers will be accepted.
- NEW! Beginning January 2025, corrugated cardboard pick-up will now be bi-weekly, on your regular recycling day.
- Corrugated cardboard must be broken down to a size no larger than 24"x18"x6" (roughly the size of a standard carry-on suitcase) and must be bundled or placed in a container.



Leaf & Yard Waste Site

- Open daily, Spring until second Monday in January.
- Must drop yard waste off at the Leaf & Yard Waste site at 2450 28th Avenue East (there is no curbside pickup).
- Accepted items include leaves, grass clippings, plants, branches, and shrubs up to 15 cm in diameter
- Mulch and screened compost available for pick up while quantities last

Garbage



- All garbage must have a visible City of Owen Sound bag tag.
- Each bag or container must be under 18 kg (40 lbs), including the container.
- A maximum of four (4) bags or containers per household is allowed, each with a bag tag.
- For garbage containers, place the bag tag on the top bag inside (not on the container) so it's visible when opened. One tag is sufficient if the total weight is under 18 kg (40 lbs).
- Extra waste can be taken to Miller Waste Transfer Station (fees apply). More info, and where to buy bag tags, at OwenSound.ca/Waste.



Hazardous Waste

- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection is held at Owen Sound's Public Works building (1900 20th Street East) from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on these Saturdays: April 26, May 24, June 14, July 12, August 16, September 13, October 4 & 25.
- Items such as aerosol cans, batteries, fertilizers, paint, oil filters, and propane tanks are accepted only at HHW events.
- Waste in damaged containers, missing lids, or leaking will not be accepted. Safely transfer items to clean, labeled containers before transport.

Goods Exchange Days

- Provides an opportunity for residents to leave items that are no longer useful to them but may still be useful to others.
- Place items at the end of your driveway or edge of your lawn on the appropriate dates listed below to indicate these are Goods Exchange Day items.
- Goods Exchange Days in 2025 are on these Saturdays:
 - May 17, July 19, September 20
